This is a fully facilitated expedition by seasoned leaders specializing in wilderness youth-leadership development. Our program also includes a community development component on the track itself.

During the expedition Students will incorporate the following core values:

INTEGRITY Being consistently honest and trustworthy.

EXCELLENCE Striving for the highest personal achievement and passion for life-long learning.

RESPECT Having regard for yourself and others, embracing cultural diversity and accepting the right of others to hold different or opposing views.

RESPONSIBILITY Being accountable for your individual and community's actions towards yourself, others and the environment.

COOPERATION Working together to achieve common goals and peacefully resolving conflict.

PARTICIPATION Being a proactive and productive individual and group member, having pride in and contributing to the community.

CARE Concern for the well-being of yourself and others, demonstrating empathy and acting with compassion.

FAIRNESS Doing the right thing in all situations, regardless of popularity.

DEMOCRACY Advocating the rights, responsibilities and freedoms of all.
