Out in the Kimberleys, eight city boys, privileged private high-schoolers and struggling street kids, must tough it out together and navigate their way back to civilisation. Inspired by leading youth organisation Camp Dare, this journey of self-discovery focuses on the youngsters making decisions for themselves and learning life skills through shared adversity.

They will have maps, compasses, tents and basic army rations. The thing they'll need most to make it through this unrelenting test of character and endurance is something they have to find within themselves - their own determination.

Team Alpha and Team Zulu are reunited. They now face the ultimate test of their willpower. The boys must decide whether to give up and take a helicopter ride to their final destination or walk the last thirteen kilometres of the 130-kilometre journey. The Camp Dare leaders, confident that the boys have acquired the skills they need to complete the journey, leave for El Questro Station.

All the boys successfully completed their journey (save for Aaron, who had to be airlifted out with Kidney stones only 3 days from the end). At El Questro they meet Aaron who has now recovered and the team celebrates their epic journey. It doesn't end there. The Camp Dare team are committed to creating real change in these boys' lives.
